DOL Unemployment Benefits

If you've lost your job or have had your hours greatly reduced, you may qualify for unemployment benefits. If you're out of work and able to work, you may be eligible for temporary income called unemployment insurance (UI). If you qualify, you receive weekly payments to help cover your living expenses while you search for new employment.
