3.1 Kierkegaard and Heidegger. Kierkegaard's work on authenticity and his suggestion that each of us is to "become what one is" (1992 [1846]: 130), is best seen as linked to his critical stance towards a certain social reality and a certain essentialist trend in philosophical and scientific thought.
